- Review/Approve Minutes February 26, 2013 Motion made by Tracey Cornell, seconded by Debbie Sluzar
- 2013 Scholarships Report
 - NYLA/SSL 7 scholarships awarded. Participants stated that the author/speaker selection was very good.
 - o Summer Leadership Institute 4 scholarships awarded
- NYSED/DLD (Dept. of Library Development) Update
 - **Governor's Budget** approved. Increase in library funding-4 million in restoration aid.
 - **New Budget Process** We will be receiving the exact amount in advance this year; budgets are no longer submitted for approval with arbitrary amounts.
 - **Research Paper Requirement** The School Library System Association is advocating for the inclusion of library language.
 - **NOVEL NY database changes** see attached flyer. Suggestion: accessing several literary databases through the New York City Library.









- SLOs 2013-2014 Requirement for librarians past issues still stand. Current guidance is that SLO requirements remain a district/local decision.

Media Library Updates

- o Recent survey on VHS usage sent to all Snap users
- This summer the VHS selection will be weeded out.
- o Currently exploring purchasing DVDs when streaming is not available

Recently purchased:

- o DVDS (40 titles)
 - o includes Ken Burns, classic literature titles, Magic School Bus (all items requested through VHS survey)
- o Audiobooks (66 titles)
 - Single user
 - o 3 collections (elementary, intermediate, high school); each with separate log-in, accessible to all
 - Exploring building level versus individual log on credentials
- o eBooks (185 titles)
 - o Majority are interactive
 - o Multiple user/simultaneous use
 - o Currently working with RIC for support
- o Skype Kits (4 kits)
 - Each kit containing a Yeti microphone, webcam, external speakers, list of authors available to skype, and skyping instructions
- o iPad Minis Loan Program a means to test and review paid apps
 - o Three iPad Minis will be available for loan
 - o Working with RIC for support
 - Will be able to recommend and preview paid app through the Media Library
 - o BOCES will purchase the app and install on the iPad
 - o User may borrow the iPad, test the app and then review it.
 - Reviewed apps will be entered into a regional "database" of apps and will remain on the iPads for others to preview.
