<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Students are welcome to attend school five (5) days per week to the Oak Tree Program housed in the Windsor Central School District. ➤ Related services will be provided in-person. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Students will log into or Google Classroom or SeeSaw classroom and participate with classmates if they are unable to attend in person instruction. ➤ If a student is absent or unable to attend he/she will log into Google Classroom or SeeSaw in accordance with their daily student schedule. ➤ Related Services: therapies will be provided in-person and with the use of teletherapy or through coordinated materials being provided to the family. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Standard-based instruction will be available synchronously and asynchronously for any student who is learning remotely. ➤ All instruction will be aligned with NYS learning standards considering possible gaps resulting from the 2019-2020 school year. ➤ Related Services: Will be provided through the use of teletherapy or through coordinated materials being provided to the family.

Teachers will provide teaching and learning that meets the needs of all students. ➤ Students will use Google Classroom as their learning platform. ➤ Traditional (percentage- based) grading per the existing grading policy will be used. ➤ Teachers will make initial contact with families via email or phone. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Students attending remotely will access their classroom via Google Classroom or SeeSaw. ➤ Families will primarily be in contact with their case manager. ➤ Standard-based grading will apply.

The case manager will collaborate with the other teachers and maintain accurate information for families. ➤ Student attendance will be taken in person when on BOCES' campus or in a BOCES district-based classroom. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ A point of contact (case manager) will be identified for groups of students so that only one teacher will contact families (not multiple). The case manager will collaborate with the other teachers and maintain accurate information for families. ➤ Student attendance will be taken by the teacher when a student logs in via zoom and/or Google/Seesaw classroom. ➤ Students and teachers will be required to actively participate. We encourage use of the video feature of Zoom during live instruction to facilitate engagement and feedback. ➤ Best practices for remote engagement/assessment will be used. Instructional practices will align with the student's IEP goals as well as the NYS learning standards. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ A point of contact (case manager) will be identified for groups of students so that only one teacher will contact families (not multiple). The case manager will collaborate with the other teachers and maintain accurate information for families. ➤ Student attendance will be taken by the teacher when a student logs in via Google/Seesaw classroom. ➤ Students and teachers will be required to use the video feature when on zoom calls (no blank screens/photos). ➤ Best practices for remote engagement/assessment will be used. ➤ Instructional practices will align with the student's IEP goals/objectives as well as the NYS learning standards.
