Get the skills and experience that will put you a step ahead, be it in college or a rewarding career.

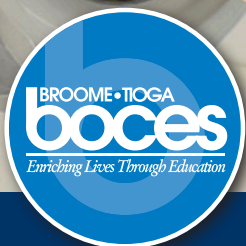
Learn safe and proper use of power and hand tools

- Learn proper plumbing installation using PEX, copper, steel pipe and PVC



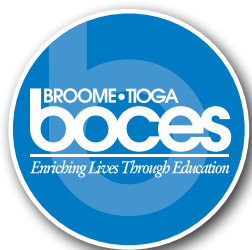
Step into college
