- 1). On, April 30, 2020, Allen Buyck, CEO and District Superintendent of Broome-Delaware-Tioga BOCES signed the Funding Certification and Agreement for the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This agreement solidified the school would disburse at least 50% to the students. This acknowledgement was submitted to the Department through the grants.gov website on 5/19/2020. On December 27, 2020 Former President Trump signed the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, (CRRSAA) 2021. This new law gave the US Dept of Education \$22.7 billion dollars to distribute to institutions of higher education. BT BOCES had already signed the Funding Certification and Agreement for the CARES Act, so the institution automatically qualified for CRRSAA funds.
- 2). BT BOCES received notification the amount of \$47,082 had been deposited into the G5 account on 1/29/2021.
- 3). As of 5/25/2021 \$47,082.94 had been distributed to students.
- 4). The estimated total number of students at Broome Delaware Tioga BOCES Program of Practical Nursing eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA was 62.
- 5). The total number who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA is 62.
- 6). The Financial Aid Office worked with Administration as to how the student relief grant money will be disbursed. The HEERF II requires that we prioritize students of greatest economic need. The amounts were calculated based on a formula using students' expected family contribution (EFC). Students were categorized into three groups and the 2020-2021 FAFSA was used for proof of EFC. See formula below.

Dear Practical Nursing Student,

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) is authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, signed into law by former President Donald J. Trump on Dec. 27, 2020. Broome Delaware Tioga BOCES Program of Practical Nursing along with all other Higher Education Institutions in the country, was awarded money through the HEERF II.

BT BOCES must disburse \$47,082 to eligible students enrolled in Title IV Eligible Training Programs at the institution. The money can be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or childcare.

Qualifying Students

The Financial Aid Office has worked with Administration as to how the student relief grant money will be disbursed. Students must be eligible citizens and be currently enrolled in the Practical Nurse program.

The HEERF II requires that we prioritize students of greatest economic need. Therefore, your amount has been calculated based on the information provided on your 2020-2021 FAFSA.
