SUBJECT: Non-Discrimination/Harassment Compliance Policy

It is the policy of the Broome-Tioga Board of Cooperative Educational Services that its practices regarding Discrimination/Harassment claims are to be in compliance with all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations. To prevent, detect, and report incidents of Discrimination/Harassment, the B-T BOCES is required to develop and implement an effective Compliance Program. The Board of Education shall meet the requirements of applicable law and regulations.

Intent

Amends Education Law to put in place procedures for the creation of school environments free of discrimination and harassment.
