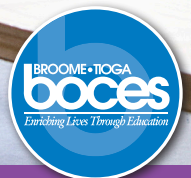

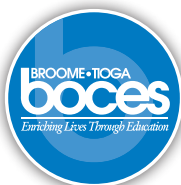
Students who successfully complete this program are prepared for the workforce. Here are a few examples of jobs awaiting successful students:
