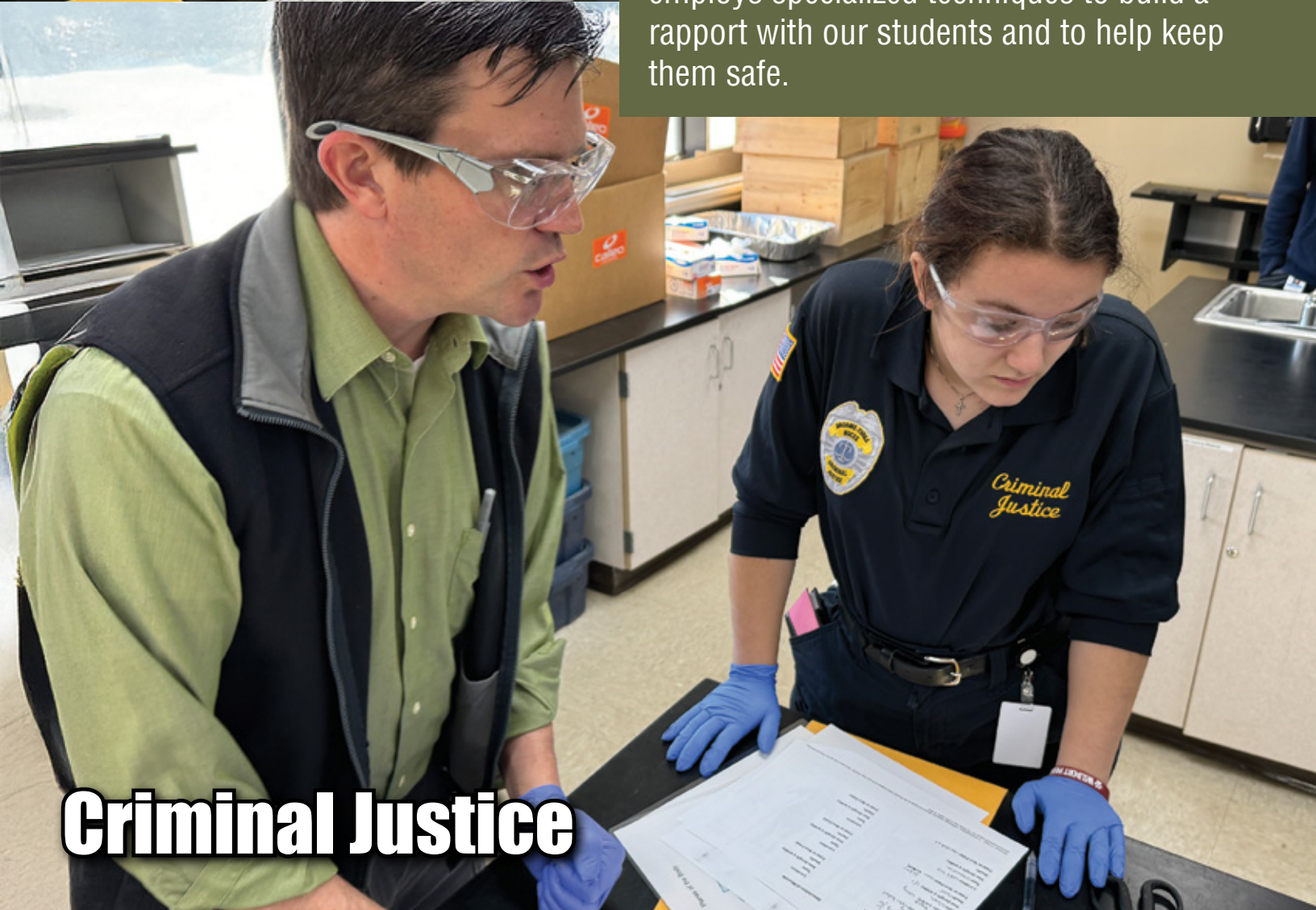


**Building Support Team**
