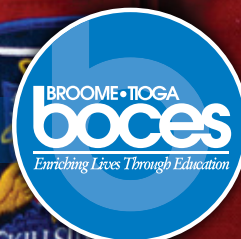

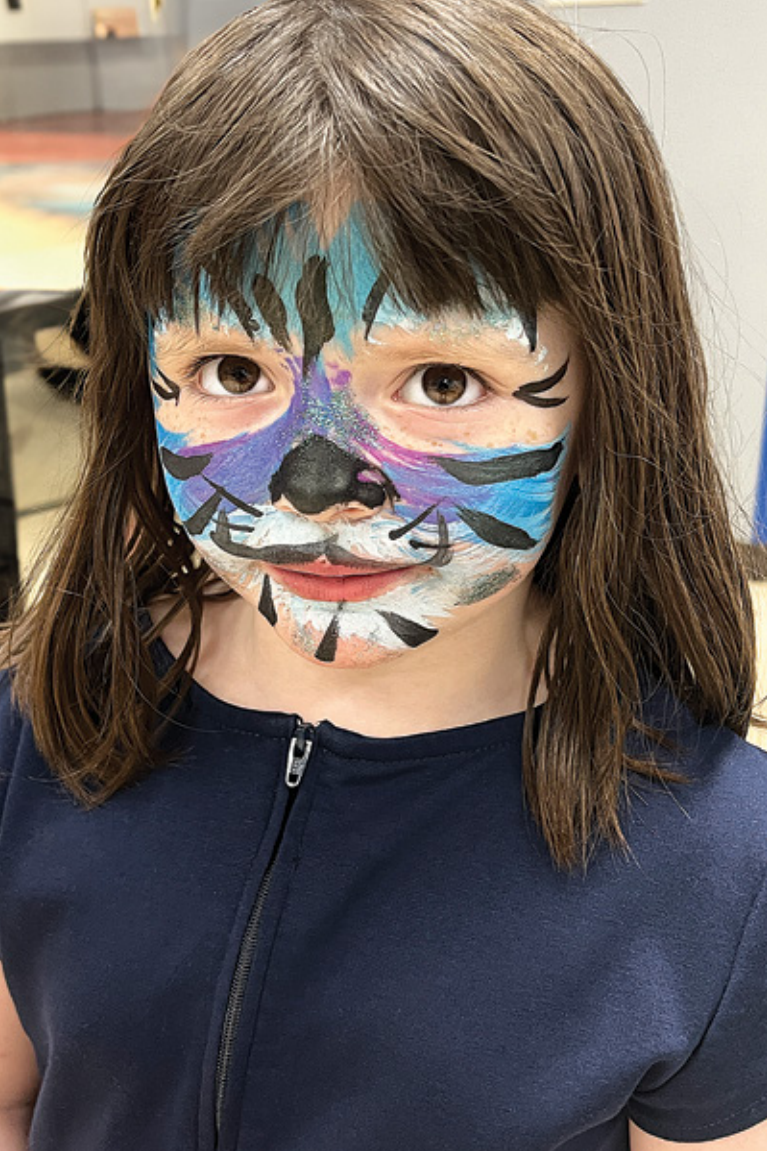
Inside: The Year's Second Half Flew Past; What a Ride It Was

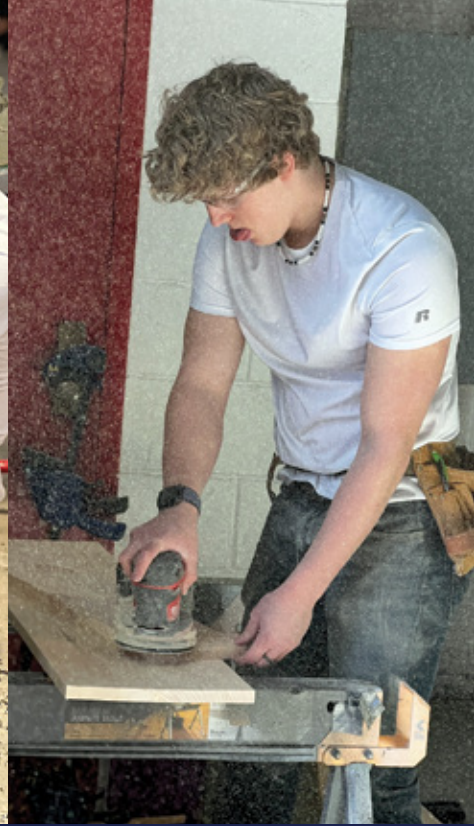




PURPOSE



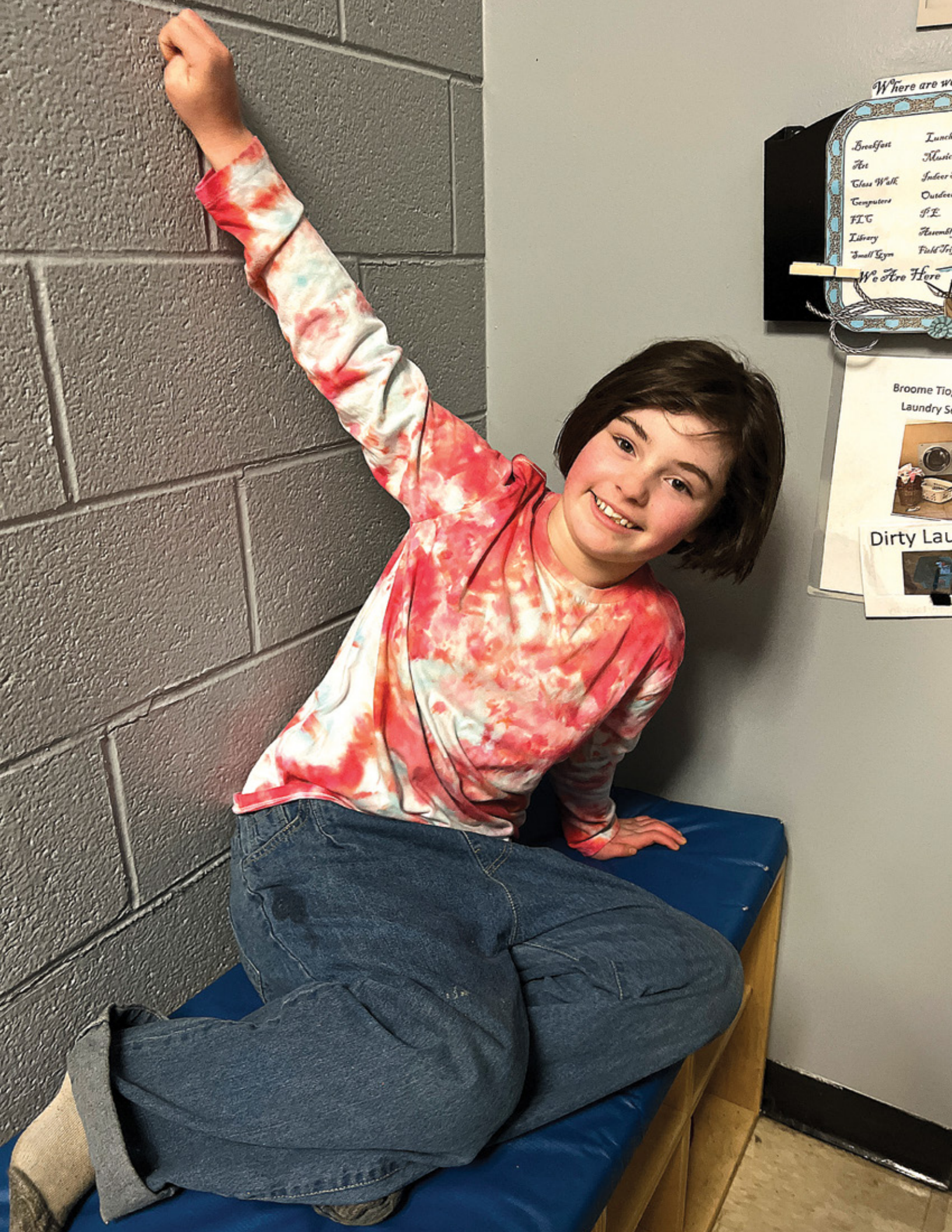

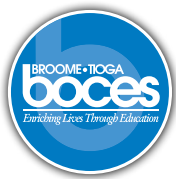

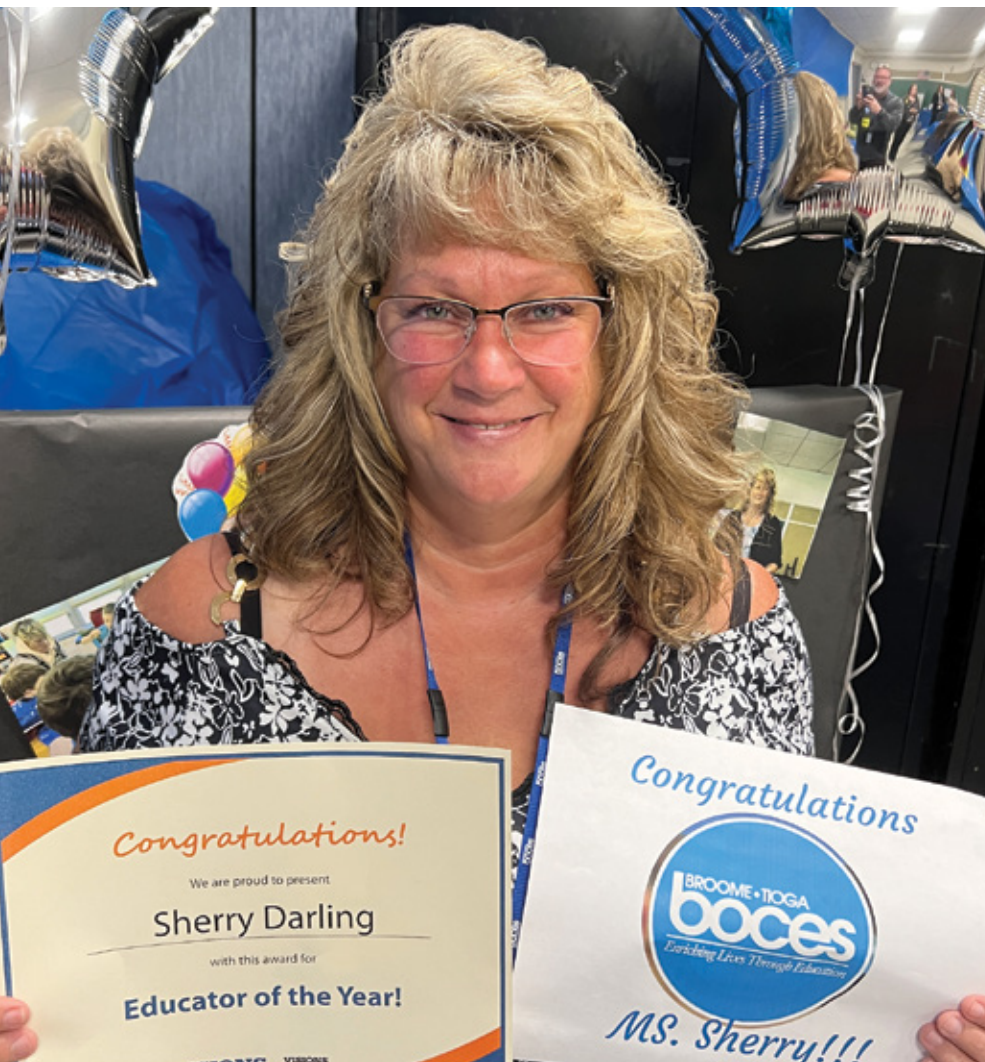
