Our program

This program is for college-bound seniors who are ready for a challenge and looking to get a step ahead toward a rewarding career. Each morning, students attend classes and work side-by-side with professionals, observing and participating in real-life experiences. They also earn social studies and English credits.

The Business Academy is geared toward students who wish to pursue a career in the field of business or related occupations, such as management, entrepreneurship, human resources, marketing and finance.

Students admitted to New Visions are active in their school community, motivated, mature and reliable young adults.

Highlights

- Students create and operate their own business under the guidelines of the Junior Achievement Company program, which provides firsthand, working knowledge in how to create and run an actual business, working side-by-side with local business professionals. Students earn an actual paycheck and possible bonus money. By participating in this program, students are eligible to apply for an academic scholarship to Syracuse University.
- Students also compete in the LaunchPad Business
 Plan Competition by creating their own business
 from start to finish and presenting their business
 plan to a panel of local professionals for the
 opportunity to win scholarship money for college
 or to start their own business.
- The program provides career-focused, real-life experiences through job shadowing opportunities in various business settings that are tailored to the student's interests. A variety of community partners can be utilized in the field of entrepreneurship, finance, marketing, communications, accounting, human resources, management, non-profit, sports management and social media marketing.
