

## Our program

This program is for students who are ready for a challenge and are looking to get a step ahead toward a rewarding teaching career. Students work side-by-side with education professionals, observing and participating in real classroom experiences, earning Social Studies and English credits.

The program is designed for college-bound seniors who wish to gain experiences working in a variety of educational settings.

## Program highlights

- Students work alongside classroom teachers, staff, and administrators to learn about all grade levels and content areas in our local schools.
- Students are trained in LSCI-NCI nonviolent crisis intervention as well as CPR/AED, DASA, become mandated reporters and NYS fingerprinting.
- Students are offered at least six hours of job shadowing experiences per week, with customizable opportunities available
- Placement opportunities in rural, urban and suburban districts.
- Partners include Broome-Tioga BOCES, Binghamton, Broome County Catholic Schools, Chenango Forks, Chenango Valley, Discovery Center, Deposit, Johnson City, Maine-Endwell, Newark Valley, Owego, Susquehanna Valley, Tioga, Union-Endicott, Vestal, Whitney Point, and Windsor school districts.
