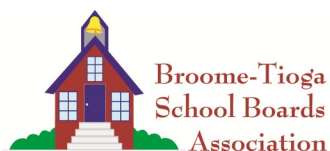


Mission As a member-driven association, we serve school boards by providing advocacy, information and programs.

- Public education as grassroots democracy

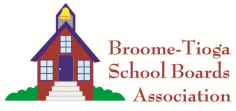
