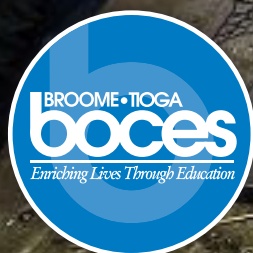

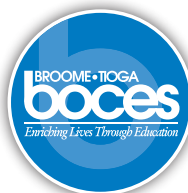
Step ahead to college
